New Rector

According the Bishop's Decrees the change of Rectors will happen on August 1, 2010: Fr. Vladimir Mudri will be installed Pastor of St. Basil Parish in Regina, and Fr. Janko Kolosnjaji will start his service as Rector in Cathedral of St. George. His installation will be during a Divine Liturgy on Sunday, August 15, 2010, at 10:00 a.m. by Bishop Bryan Bayda, CSSR.

Fr. Janko was born in Ruski Kerestur (former Yugoslavia) on June 27, 1953. He graduated High school at Ukrainian Catholic Minor Seminary in Rome. In Rome he also started University of Theology and then completed in Zagreb in 1988. He was ordained priest on April 17, 1988. Parishes he served: as Parish Vicar in Ruski Kerestur (1988-1992) then as Pastor in North Battleford since 1992 until present.

You are welcomed to the Cathedral Parish, Father Janko and family. His wife is Genka and they have four boys: Alexander, Vladimir, Joakim and Ivan.

For anyone's curiosity

This page appeared on the first Sunday in January, giving the statistics as of December 31, 2009. Here I am updating and advancing the same page with data for the time I will be leaving Saskatoon, July 31, 2010.

Vladimir Mudri was ordained by Bishop Gabriel Bukatko and became priest on August 27, 1972. Arrived to Canada on March 21, 1974. After two weeks at Cudworth with Fr. Lubomyr Ramach, was invited to help with services in Cathedral during Holy Week and 1974 Easter. On April 20, 1974 by the Dean Fr. Jerome Lashkewich he was installed as Pastor of Preceville and District. Already September 4, 1975 he was nominated Pastor at Sutherland & Parochial Vicar of St. George's Cathedral. He lived at old St. George's Residence with Fr. John Olynyk as Pastor, Fr. Wolodymyr Iwaszko as the first Assistant Priest, Fr. Peter Kryworuchka as the second and Fr. Vladimir Mudri as the third Assistant Priest at the Cathedral. With regular services at Cathedral Fr. Mudri started on September 29, 1975 and remained assigned to the Cathedral until October 15, 1984. In this period of time from 1975 to 1984 were interruptions in service at Cathedral when Fr. Mudri studying in Rome 1979-1982 (back in Saskatoon May to October of each year), as well when helping in Canora from May to July 1984. Fr. Mudri left Saskatoon as of October 15, 1984 when he assumed responsibilities as Pastor of All Saints Parish at North Battleford & District. On October 15, 1992 he is back in Saskatoon as Rector of St. George's Cathedral and here until present time.

As priest Fr. Mudri celebrated until now:

305 Baptisms with Chrismations; 252 First Confessions & Solemn Communions; 98 Weddings; 576 Funerals; a total of 14,224 Divine Liturgy from which 1005 in Yugoslavia; 22 in Australia; 554 at Preceville; 995 at Rome; 2,878 at North Battleford; 98 at Canora & other places in Canada and at Cathedral 8,772;

This Sunday is my formal farewell to St. George's Cathedral. According to the Bishop's decrees, since August 1st the new Rector will be here and I am transferred to Regina. It is an emotional time for me, since more than half of my priestly service was in here at St. George's Cathedral Parish. Services at the Cathedral I started on September 25, 1975 as Parish Vicar until October 15, 1984 when I became Pastor at All Saints Parish in North Battleford, and then again, I returned to the Cathedral as the Rector on October 15, 1992. During 26 year period in the parish I was involved in various venues. Looking back, there were some tense and articulate situations, but a big majority were happy and satisfying. The former were forgiven and forgotten, the latest will remain in long lasting memory.

At this time, I like to express my gratitude to the Parish Council members, present and those that served at the Council in the past, for their great stewardship and cooperation. The leadership in the parish requests a lot of time, energy and good will. A big majority of Parish Council members are very generous for the good of the Parish. They deserve a huge Thank you from every parishioner.

Starting with Sisters, cantors and choirs a big Thank you goes to various parish Organizations, Groups and Committees for their involvement, help and donations. It would be difficult if not impossible for our parish to function.

Last but not the least, a Thank you to all parishioners. Through those registered as a parish, the parish as the essential cell of the Church, is able to fulfill the mission of the Church: actualize the salvation of the people in present time and place. This is the outmost dignity and responsibility when together all people and priest cooperate in the accomplishment of the Mission of Jesus Christ on the earth. You will continue this endeavours here with a new Rector, and I will be doing the same with a new parish at Regina. As Church we will be always united. I will pray for you, and you pray for me at the new place. Thank you.
